The family of Nancy B. Barr and Four County Community Foundation are pleased to sponsor college and vocational scholarships to graduates of an Adult Education Program in Romeo, Capac, Almont or Armada. Scholarship applications are open to individuals who meet the following criteria:

- 1) Hold a grade point average of 2.5 or above;
- 2) Have a minimum of 80% attendance of scheduled classes;
- 3) Complete a scholarship application for the Nancy B. Barr Adult Education Scholarship Fund.
- 4) For students currently enrolled in college or vocational courses and seek funding, transcripts from the current school are required, in addition to all other forms and letters listed in this application.

The scholarships are available for full or part time students. Applications are for a one year college or vocational scholarship. Students receiving funding will be eligible to reapply by submitting a new application and current transcripts for future consideration.

The scholarship shall be used for tuition, fees and books. The scholarship check shall be issued after proof of enrollment, in a college or post high school vocational program, has been submitted to the Foundation.

The **deadline for applications is April 1st. They must be received in the Four County Community Foundation offices on or before that date for consideration.** Additional information **may be requested** from finalists in the screening process. Grants will be recommended to the Board of Trustees of the Four County Community Foundation following the application deadline. Successful candidates will be notified in writing.
